# FULL HOUSE DECONSTRUCTION

**GREENWOOD VILLAGE, COLORADO** 

- Built in the 1980s
- 7,000 sqft house
- completed in 38 days with a team of 5
- 125,000 lbs of material diverted from the landfill
- 91,500 lbs in wood diverted from the landfill

The homeowners were really interested in reusing materials from their deconstruction project. They saved the red cedar siding to make garden beds and will use the majority of the lumber that we salvaged for reuse on their new construction project.

# FULL HOUSE DECONSTRUCTION BOULDER, COLORADO

- Built in 1880s
- 2300 sqft
- completed in 30 days
- 115,000 lbs of material diverted from the landfill
- 18,000 lbs of wood diverted from the landfill

Old growth wood, batt insulation, palletized brick was reused on site; other brick got recycled and/or used as backfill at another job site.




## NEW BRANDING & WEBSITE
